

DATA AND INFORMATION ABOUT SOME SIGNIFICANT PROJECTS REGARDING "P.E.P."

The data provided are provisional as calls for projects regarding migrant workers employed in agricultural sector, financed by Apulia Region, are still open (deadline is november 17, 2008).

"Progetti a sostegno dell'emersione del lavoro non regolare nel settore dell'agricoltura"

By mean of two different calls for tenders was possible to finance:

- 11 projects proposed by private employers;
- 11 projects proposed by local authorities in partnership with several associations and charities engaged in social services.

The following provisional results for each financed action cover the period from july the first to august 30th, 2008.

Projects proposed by private employers financed:

- accomodation in private homes provided by employers for their agricultural workers covered about a total of 110 workers a day;
- transport services organized by employers for their agricultural workers covered about a total of 146 workers a day.

Projects proposed by local authorities in partnership financed:

- accomodation in "Temporary workers homes" for a total of 1170 workers from different nationalities. The nationalities presented are:
 - African: Ghana, Burkina Faso, Morocco, Ivory Coast, Sudan, Nigeria, Senegal, Tunisia, Sierra Leone, Togo, Madagascar;
 - European: Italy, Romania, Poland, Bulgaria, Albania, Ukraine.
- transport services from the towns or cities center to the working places transported in average of 1030 agricultural workers a week in a period of two months.

"ALBERGO DIFFUSO"

"Albergo diffuso" is a project regarding the renovation of buildings to be reserved for the accomodation of migrant agricultural workers employed in the Foggia province, Apulia.

The following provisional results cover only the period from June the first to September 30th, 2008 as project is still in progress.

Accommodation facilities (currently able to host a maximum of 150 workers a night) hosted a total of 90 workers every night during summer 2008 and were able to deliver one meal a day for 80 workers.

“OSSERVATORIO REGIONALE ECONOMIA SOMMERSA (O.R.E.S.)”

The Regional Observatory for the unregulated work and the black market economy is a project aimed at the creation a network among supervisory bodies, responsible for the control of the labour market, on the one hand; and aimed at offering data and information for study and research, on the other hand, by mean of data sharing agreements and the integration of information flows.
